#### 1. Funding & Finances

- \$16,000 Arts Operating Fund Paul and Kim were in attendance. The meeting went well and both sides left with a better understanding of each other. We will be adding Directors salaries (donation in kind) to the finances.
- \$5,000 Youth Investment Fund (Jazz Community tour) will be requested annually.
- \$1,000 Artists In the Schools (Jazz Community tour)
- \$600 Parks & Recreation (December concert)
- ~\$25,000 Experiences Canada (Maple Ridge Trip)
- \$300 Music Yukon (Arts in the Park)
- \$89.60 in donations from the Arts in the Park concert

There is \$7,800 in surplus that needs to be spent by September. Some suggestions are:

- a new multifunction printer
- cleaning of brass instruments
- a trailer for hauling equipment
- new signboards (Keith to look into)

Motion: To give website developers \$600 each for their efforts on creating a new website.
