1. Sponsorship

We received \$4000 less from Arts Fund this year. Kris Smith is in charge of auctions for Dessert and Dance. Kris will also take the lead with the sponsorship committee as both sponsorship and auction donations should be coordinated together.

2. Finances & Review Engagement

Sonia would need a license to do the review and would also not be allowed to be on the board due to a conflict of interest. A license would cost \$1000.

\$9200 surplus from last year still remains. Increased over the summer due to band members leaving and forfeiting their funds to the band.

Some ideas to spend the money:

- purchase instruments being sold 2nd hand.
- jazz band retreat with performers from Jazz Yukon.
- subsidize the April band trip.
- cover the \$1000 license fee for Sonia to do the review.

Decision was made to subsidize the April band trip and pay for Sonia's license.

Jennifer has offered to take on the Quickbooks portion of the Treasurer duties as Swapan is unlikely to continue next year.

3. Grants

- a. Canadian Heritage fund got \$14,700; to be split evenly between the performers after concert costs have been covered.
- b. Need to do an application to the Elks for \$1000 for this year's Christmas concerts.
- c. Jazz trip YIF and Artist in the School. Plan is to travel to Carcross, Teslin and Watson Lake.
- d. CARAS this year for PC may offer \$10,000 towards the purchase of instruments.
- e. Parks & Rec grant moved to August
- f. Holland America for Dessert & Dance application has been submitted. Awaiting response.
