- **c. Arts Fund** The Jazz band members need to submit writings to the Arts Fund to promote the Jazz band. A trip is planned for Pelly Crossing, Dawson City and Mayo. If Arts Fund is not able to provide funds then we may approach the youth investment fund.
- **d. CARAS** Application for \$10,000 for new instruments will be submitted for PCSS this year.
- e. Motion for the Parks & Rec grant.
